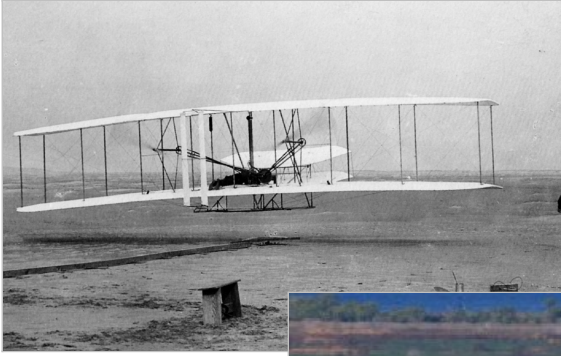

Wg Cdr Tony Davies captained V-bombers (**Vulcan & Victor**) worldwide, as well as being a **RAF aerobatic display pilot**. After flying, he was a staff officer at National & NATO HQs and the **RAF Staff College**. Upon leaving the RAF, he joined **BAe Systems**.

Tony Davies has a **vast knowledge of a lot of aircraft**, and he will be outlining a **wide spectrum of the aviation world**, concentrating 'powered flight' from the **Wright Brothers**, flying the first powered aeroplane - the **Wright Flyer** in 1903, up to the age when the **Space Shuttle** landed at Cape Canaveral from the 80's up to 2011.
