Flying the Vulcans

Sqn Ldr Joe Marsden flew **34 different Vulcan** aircraft, including **XH558**, which many will have seen at airshows until 2016, and **XL426** which is currently in live ground running condition at Southend Airport.

Flying higher than airliners, at nearly the speed of sound, Joe burned 1,000 gallons of fuel per hour in those iconic Vulcan bombers.

Joe's talk will concentrate on the Vulcan - illustrated by photos and film clips, to show its capability. He will briefly cover the **history** of the Vulcan, together with the **personal aspects of flying this famous aircraft**. Joe will cover **crew responsibilities, preparation** and the **practicalities** of the various roles that he was involved in, without missing the more light-hearted aspects of the job.

His journey took him from **Cyprus** in the East, to **Midway Island** and **Alaska** in the West, as well as up into the **Arctic Circle** to test the **Russian response**.
